English

This term, thrive 1 will be diving into the world of Gothic literature, exploring its eerie atmosphere, dark themes, and intriguing characters. Our main focus will be on the story of *The Corpse Bride*, where we will unravel its unique blend of romance and mystery. Through this engaging tale, students will learn about key elements of Gothic fiction and the powerful emotions these stories evoke.

Science

Science: This term in science, thrive 1 will be exploring the fascinating topic of light. Maths

Humanities

History: This term in history, thrive 1 will be delving into the topic of leisure and entertainment, exploring how people have spent their free time throughout history. From early forms of public entertainment like theatre and sports to the rise of cinema and modern-day technology, students will examine how leisure activities have evolved and shaped cultures. They will also consider how social changes, and technological advancements have influenced the ways people relax and enjoy themselves.

Geography: This term in Geography, thrive 1 will be learning about different types of settlements. Students will explore how settlements, such as villages, towns, and cities, are structured and what factors influence where and how people live. They will learn about the characteristics of rural and urban settlements, the role of transportation, and how the environment and economy impact settlement patterns. Through this topic, students will gain a deeper understanding of how human geography shapes communities around the world

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PSHE

This term in PSHE, thrive 1 will be learning about puberty, emotional health, and well-being.
